Eligibility and Membership Requirements/Program Participation Requirements

All Explorer participants must:

- Be between the ages of 14 and 20 an enrolled full time in school having completed the 8th grade
- Maintain a GPA of no less than a 2.0 or a C average equivalent, with no grades of an “F” rating (or its equivalent)
- Have no significant criminal history
- Be in good disciplinary standing at school
- Be a United States citizen or Lawful Permanent Resident residing full time in the United States
- Participate in fundraising activities
- Participate in community service projects
- Attend meetings regularly and arrive on time
- Arrive to meetings in proper uniform

Explorer Fees

- Explorers are responsible for an initial registration fee of \$75.00 at the time of registration.
- Explorer dues, in the amount of \$5.00, shall be collected the first meeting of every month.

Attendance Policy

The U.S. Customs and Border Protection Explorer Post#306 will hold regular post meetings every other Tuesday from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. and a physical training day once a month. Explorers are expected to attend all meetings and physical training days. In the event that an Explorer is unable to attend a meeting or physical training day, they are **required** to call the Explorer Hotline (313-355-4227) and leave a message stating they are unable to attend. This message shall include the date, time and reason for absence (work, exams, sick). When leaving a message for an absence of sick the Explorer is **not** required to give the nature of their illness. If an Explorer is going to be late they shall also call the hotline number.

If an Explorer is absent and fails to call in they will receive a No Call No Show (NCNS) for that day. If an Explorer accrues three **(3)** NCNS they will be removed from the program.
